2016 Basic Sailing Class

If you ever wanted to learn to sail, now is your chance. The Titusville Sailing Club will be sponsoring a Basic Sailing Class in May. Classes are 4 consecutive Saturdays. You will be on the water sailing on the first day of class.

Class Dates: 7, 14, 21, 28, May 2016

Day/Time: Saturdays 9:00 AM – 1:00 PM

You Provide:

- Closed-toe footwear that will get wet (wading shoes or old tennis or boat shoes to protect your feet from the river bottom. No Sandals or flip-flops.
- Personal Floatation Device (Life Jacket)
- Towel, Sunscreen
- Minimum age 16. 14 or younger accepted if accompanied by an adult in the class and the instructor concurs.

The Class Includes:

- US Sailing Certified Sailing Instructor
- Use of Sunfish Sailboat

This class will teach you how to be safe on the water in a sailboat. Students will learn to rig and sail a Sunfish sailboat. Students are typically paired up as skipper and crew on one boat, then progress into sailing alone in a Sunfish. At the end of the class, students will understand the Rules of the Road for maritime traffic and be able to confidently sail a small boat in light to medium air. Class meets at the Titusville Sailing Club House next to Sand Point Park, Titusville Florida. We are on the second floor. Use the stairs on the north side of the building.

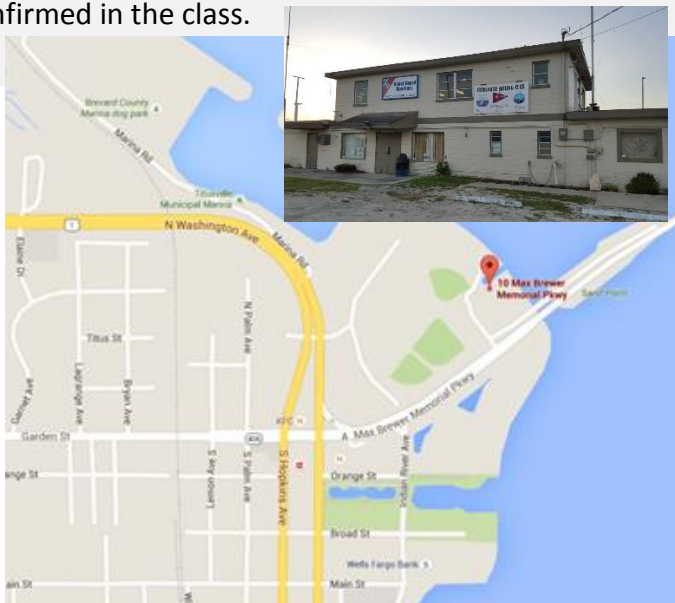
Maximum 16 students per class. Register early, class fills up quickly. Once we receive payment, you will be confirmed in the class.
